



CAMPINGSITES REGULATIONS

1°) CONDITIONS OF ADMISSION

no admission or setting on a campsite is allowed without the autorisation of the reception office. The manager of the campsite is responsible for the implementation of these regulations.

When you are staying on the campsite it means that you willingly accept to comply with these present regulations.

2-) POLICE FORMALITIES

Every person staying at least one night on the camp site must show his identity papers at the reception desk and carry out the police formalities

None unaccompanied person under 18 will be admitted on the campsite without a written autorisation from their parents.

3°) OCCUPATION OF THE PITCHES

The tent or the caravan and other camping equipments must be put at the place indicated by the camp manager.

4°) RECEPTION OFFICE

Open from 8h to 12h and from 14h to 18h

In the reception office, all information about campsite facilities, possibilities of foodstuff on the spot, sport grounds and outdoor games, interesting sight-seeing and usefull addresses will be provided.

A book or a special box for complaints will be taken into consideration provided they are signed, dated as detailed as possible and related to recent events..

5°) CHARGES

Charges have to be paid in the reception office. The amount is fixed according to annexed prices. They are payable according to the number of nights spent on the campsite.

When the campers intend to leave the campsite, they are asked to inform the reception office the day before leaving. If the campers want to leave before the reception office is opened, they have to pay their charges the day before.

6°) NOISE AND SILENCE, ANIMALS

Campers are asked to avoid noise and discussion whiche may disturb their neighbours. They are also asked to turn down radios, transistors, tapes or cassette-recorders if need be. Car doors and boots must be closed quietly. Silence must be total between 22 pm and 7 am..

Anyone entering the campsite with a dog or a cat has to show the identity card and the certificate of antirabies vaccination of the animal. Animals have to wear heir identification collars. According to the 211-1article of the country code, the first dog category « assault dog » are forbidden, the second dog category « guard dog » must be muzzled ans kept on a leash by a major person. Dogs and otehr animals can not be left on the campsite even locked in, when their masters, who are responsible for them are away.

7°) VISITEURS

Visitors are allowed but their hosts are in charge of them. When visitors are allowed to stay on the campsite, their hosts might have to pay some fees in so far as the visitors take advantage of the campsite's equipments.

The amount that has to be payed is displayed at the entrance of the campsite and the reception office. Visitors 'cars are strictly forbidden on the campsite.

8°) CIRCULATION ET STATIONNEMENT DES VEHICULES

Inside the campsite the speed limit is 10 kph. Traffic is forbidden from 10,00 pm to 7,00 am. Only campers staying on the campsite can drive inside the campsite. Parking on tent or caravan pitches is stricly prohibited. Parking must not disturb the traffic or new comers settling.

9°) THE KEEPING AND LOOK OF THE CAMPSITE EQUIPMENTS

Do respect the tidiness and the hygiene of the camp. Do not throw dirty water on the ground or in the gutters. The campers must trows their sullage away in appropriate places. The campers must be respectful to the campsite installations especially to the sanitary blocks. Put

household refuse, other waste and filthy papers into the refuse containers. No washing is allowed outside the appropriate sinks. The washing can be hung up in the drying room, if there is one, however until 10,00 am it is allowed near the tents and caravans providing it will not disturb the neighbours. Do take care of trees, plants and flowers. A camper is not allowed to drive nails in the trees, to cut branches or to plant. Do not mark off plots yourself. Do not dig into the ground. All damage done to the plants, the fences, the site or the campsite installations must be paid by the offender. The pitch has to be left in the same state as it was found on arrival.

10°) SECURITE

a) Fire : open fires are prohibited. Cooking apparatus must be in excellent conditions. Fire extinguishers are at everybody's disposal. In case of fire, inform the camp manager immediatly. A first aid outfit is available at the reception office.

b) Theft

The campsite is only responsible for the articles committed to the care of the reception office. Please inform the camp manager of the presence of any suspect person.

Though the campsite is guarded, the campers are asked to take care of their equipments.

11°) JEUX

No rough or disturbing games are allowed near the camping installations. The common room can only be used for quiet games. Parents are responsible for their children.

12°) UNOCCUPIED TENTS AND CARAVANS

Unoccupied tents or caravans should not be left on the campsite without the approval of the camp manager and only on the pitch indicated. When caravans or tents are left permanently on the site, the camper has to pay some charges (amount displayed at the reception office).

13°) DISPLAY OF THE CAMPSITE REGULATIONS

These campsite regulations are displayed at the entrance of the campsite and at the

reception office, and can be obtained on request.

14°) OFFENCE TO THE PRESENT CAMPSITE REGULATIONS

In case of campers disturbing the stay of others holidaymakers, the camp manager is entitled to penalize the people who break the rules and he might turn them out. In case of penal infraction, the camp manager will call the police force.

II – SPECIAL CONDITIONS

Caravans with double axle are not allowed in the campsite.
